

VASCULAR PLANTS OF BENTON COUNTY, OREGON, U.S.A.: A CHECKLIST

ABSTRACT

The vascular flora of Benton County, Oregon, is reported based on the databases of the OregonFlora synonymized checklist and O.S.U. Herbarium databases and field collections. A total of 1213 terminal taxa were found representing 542 genera in 116 families. In Benton County can be found 25% of Oregon's flora.

RESUMEN

Se informa de la flora vascular del condado de Benton, Oregón, a partir de las bases de datos de la lista de comprobación sinonimizada OregonFlora y de las bases de datos del Herbario de la O.S.U. y las colecciones de campo. Se encontró un total de 1213 taxones terminales que representan 542 géneros en 116 familias. En el condado de Benton se encuentra el 25% de la flora de Oregón.

INTRODUCTION




FIG. 1. Oregon county map with Benton County highlighted.

The decision to document the flora of Benton County, Oregon (Fig. 1), was precipitated by two primary factors: the start of the Oregon Flora Project (now OregonFlora) in 1994 and the start of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020. OregonFlora, in conjunction with the Oregon State University Herbarium, databased all Oregon collections of non-cultivated plants as part of the goal to produce a modern flora of the state. The database made it relatively easy to produce a list of plants collected in Benton County. The COVID-19 pandemic and its subsequent lockdowns necessitated a reduction of travel and thus a closer focus of the plants found nearer to home. Subsequently during the years 2020–2024 a focus of collecting was Benton County. Questions we hope to answer as a result of the checklist include: 1). What plants are found in Benton County? Are they native or exotic? 2). When were they collected? Are new taxa (native or exotic) being found? Are there plants that are no longer present in the flora? 3). Is Benton County well collected in relation to other counties in Oregon? 4). Which taxa in Benton County are listed noxious weeds?

Study Area

Benton County, established in 1847 (Oregon Blue Book 2021), is located in western Oregon (Fig. 1), west of the Cascade Mountains, in the Willamette Valley. On the north it is bounded by Polk County, on the west by Lincoln County, on the south by Lane County, and on the east by Linn County. The eastern boundary between Benton and Linn counties is the Willamette River. Benton County is the fourth smallest county in Oregon by land area (676 square miles) while the land area of Oregon is 95,988 square miles (2,391 square miles water area) (Oregon Blue Book 2021). The primary cities in the county are Adair Village, Philomath, Albany, Monroe and Corvallis with the latter being the county seat and the home of Oregon State University.

Benton County is divided approximately in half, north to south, into two ecoregions: the Coast Range and the Willamette Valley (Albert 2015). For a description of these ecoregions and the habitats that occur within them see Albert (2015) or Franklin and Dyrness (1973).

Benton County has three features that make it interesting: 1). Marys Peak, with an elevation of ca. 1250 meters (4100 feet) is the highest peak in the Coast Range. 2). The William L. Finley National Wildlife Refuge is the site of some of the last undisturbed native prairie in the Willamette Valley. 3). It is the home of Oregon State University and its herbarium (OSC).

The herbarium at Oregon State University (OSC) in Corvallis was founded in the 1890s, initially curated by Moses Craig. More recently OSC has absorbed two other major collections: Willamette University (WILLU) in 1976 and the University of Oregon (ORE) in 1993.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Nomenclature generally follows that of the *Flora of Oregon* vol. 1 (2015), which covers Pteridophytes, Gymnosperms and Monocots, vol. 2 (2020), which covers the Dicot families Aizoaceae through Fagaceae, and the forthcoming vol. 3, which will cover the families Garryaceae through Zygophyllaceae. The remainder follow the 2nd edition of the *Flora of the Pacific Northwest* (2018). When names have changed, the appropriate synonyms appear in brackets after the given name. However, a taxon search in the OregonFlora database (<https://oregonflora.org>) can be referenced for a full account of recognized names used in other regional floras which are synonyms of taxa in the Benton County list not mentioned.

An initial plant list for this project was drafted exclusively using a database of O.S.U. Herbarium specimens (including OSC, ORE and WILLU vouchers). This relational database includes synonymy of 15,468 scientific names and 172,446 O.S.U. Herbarium collections (from Oregon, growing outside of cultivation). All Oregon collections at O.S.U. have been entered in the database, which is maintained in its own Symbiota portal (<https://oregonflora.org>). Because accurate identifications of Oregon vouchers were a critical step in developing the checklist and distributions for taxa described in *Flora of Oregon*, determinations for the majority of Oregon specimens at the O.S.U. Herbarium have been evaluated since the Oregon Flora Project's inception in 1994.

All current determinations for the selected specimens were translated to the recognized name in the Oregon Flora synonymized checklist database. Scientific names from the list were then reviewed for dubious identifications. The draft list was also used to find new taxa through a targeted collecting effort. All new collections were accessioned at OSC. Once the list of taxa was finalized the taxonomic database was queried to determine the origin (native or exotic) for every listed taxon.

Plants in the Benton County checklist are not distinguished between OSC, ORE and WILLU; most of them are found in OSC but a few are in ORE or WILLU. Trying to examine other herbaria for specimens and determining their correct identity would have been too time consuming and difficult.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

A total of 1213 terminal taxa were found and documented within the county (Table 1). Of this number 694 are considered to be native and 519 to be exotic. Twenty-five percent of Oregon's total terminal taxa can be found in Benton County. The largest families and genera are found in Table 2.

The checklist denotes exotic species, or non-native species, with an "E." Benton County has 40% of Oregon's exotic terminal taxa. Included within this group are plants considered to be noxious weeds by the state of Oregon (ONW 2024). These are indicated by a "W" in the checklist and are listed in Table 3. These are fully treated in *Flora of Oregon* (2015, 2020) and are usually considered to be naturalized, or common escapes from gardens or fields that persist and may be common weeds. Sixty-one of the listed exotic taxa are waifs, marked with "#" in the checklist. These are plants found in the wild that typically do not persist or only do so for a few generations. Waifs are usually plants that escape from gardens or other types of plantings and are not treated in *Flora of Oregon* (2015, 2020).

Benton County is home to 20% of Oregon's native terminal taxa. If a native plant has not been collected (and deposited at the O.S.U. Herbarium) within the last 50 years in Benton County it is arbitrarily presumed to be extirpated (Table 4). There are 131 taxa in this table. These taxa are denoted by an "X" in the checklist. This is a significant number. It can best be explained by the increased loss of native habitat through urbanization, agricultural usage and forestry practices. Some taxa may have always been rare and have become extinct within the county. Some taxa listed as extirpated may still occur in Benton County but are under collected as they are difficult to access, cumbersome to collect, not of interest to collectors, or diminutive in stature and are therefore un-noticed. It is hoped that the list of extirpated taxa provides a target for future collecting in the county.

Benton County has only nine species that are listed by the State of Oregon to be of conservation concern: *Sisyrinchium hitchcockii* (Iridaceae), *Lomatium bradshawii* (Apiaceae), *Erigeron decumbens* (Asteraceae), *Lathyrus holochlorus* and *Lupinus oreganus* (Fabaceae), *Sidalcea nelsoniana* (Malvaceae), *Castilleja levisecta* (Orobanchaceae), *Navarretia willamettensis* (Polemoniaceae), and *Delphinium pavonaceum* (Ranunculaceae) (ORBIC 2023). These are denoted with an "R" in the checklist. *Castilleja levisecta* Greenm., golden paintbrush, a very rare species that has been reintroduced to the William L. Finley National Wildlife Refuge, is not on the Benton County list but does occur here now.

Table 5 lists those taxa newly found in Benton County since the start of this project in 2020. This list includes a total of 55 taxa of which 43 are exotic and 12 are native. It is not unusual to find new weeds in a county (*Cyperus esculentus*) or cultivated escapes either of agricultural (*Avena sativa*) or ornamental (*Calendula officinalis*) origin. Of the exotic taxa 14 are considered waifs. But finding at this late date new native species (*Heuchera micrantha*, *Melica harfordii*) is unusual. One would expect a higher ratio of recent collections of exotics as compared to natives as new exotics are continually introduced as either weeds or escapes from cultivation. The low number of native species found is not unusual since Benton County, home of the O.S.U. Herbarium, is very well collected.

Abundance of each taxon in the county is based on the number of specimens of that taxon in the O.S.U. Herbarium. This method may not be indicative of actual frequency of occurrence. Common weeds or native plants may be so recognizable (such as *Taraxacum officinale*, *Rubus spectabilis*) that they are not collected. Hence, they are very common in the county but the number specimens in the herbarium do not reflect that.

That seems to be true with chicory (*Cichorium intybus*) and bracken (*Pteridium aquilinum*), for example. Conversely, many of the county's rare taxa have been very well collected by botanists charged with documenting their populations.

Oregon has 36 counties. The O.S.U. Herbarium has collections from throughout Oregon but not all counties have been equally collected (Table 6). One measurement of our knowledge of a county flora is its total number of collections. This table lists the top ten counties by the number of collections present in the herbarium and ranks each county as determined by size (square miles). Harney County ranks first as it is the largest of Oregon's 36 counties. Lane County ranks sixth but was also the home of the University of Oregon Herbarium. It stretches from the crest of the Cascades to the Pacific coast which accounts for a high number of collections from the county. As can be seen counties large in area, such as Harney, Klamath and Lake counties, tend to be well collected. Smaller counties that are rich in endemic species and other unique taxa, such as Josephine, Jackson, Curry, and Wallowa counties also rank high on this list. Benton County can be compared to Polk, Yamhill and Washington counties as they are similar in size and all are the same ecoregions. Polk County has 1177 collections (rank 30), Washington County has 904 collections (rank 31) and Yamhill County has 806 collections (rank 32). Benton County stands out because of its small size and large number of collections, primarily due to the presence of O.S.U. Herbarium.

The O.S.U. Herbarium was founded in the 1890's but very few specimens from Benton County are found in the herbarium with collection dates before 1915. The reason for this is uncertain. It seems that the first major collections from the county were by Henry Gilbert, a graduate student, who wrote his thesis on the weeds of the Willamette Valley in 1917. Then in 1918 Helen Gilkey became curator of the herbarium and collections from the county were more frequent. Since that time collections from the county have added to the herbarium at a steady rate by students, O.S.U. Extension Service personnel, amateur botanists, and staff at the O.S.U. Herbarium.

What information may be gleaned from the history of the collections? Waifs come and go (*Senecio × albescens*, *Muscaria comosum*). Some may eventually become naturalized and be a part of the Oregon flora (*Leucojum aestivum*, *Nigella damascena*). Non-native plants, new to Benton County, but found elsewhere in the state are introduced (*Poa bulbosa*, *Brassica nigra*, *Hypochaeris glabra*) and are likely to stay. The same can be said for noxious weeds (*Centaurea stoebe*, *Rosa canina*). Native plants were collected early in the history of the herbarium (*Abies procera*, *Berberis aquifolium*) or late (*Sagittaria latifolia*, *Acer glabrum*). However, the most important information is the list of presumed extirpated native plants (Table 4).

Future studies of Benton County's flora will result in new native taxa being found, but these will undoubtedly be fewer in number than the non-native plants. What will be more interesting is if some of the presumed extirpated plants can be found. It is hoped that the list of extirpated taxa here presented will encourage deposit of collections at the O.S.U. Herbarium.

ANNOTATED CHECKLIST

There are usually two vouchers listed for each taxon, the earliest collected voucher from Benton County by year (in parentheses) and the latest voucher by year (in parentheses). If just one voucher is cited the taxon was collected once. Vouchers are in the Oregon State University Herbarium (OSC). Plants with an "E" after the dates are considered exotic or non-native and plants with a "#" are considered to be waifs; plants with a "W" after the dates are considered by the state of Oregon to be noxious weeds; plants with an "R" after the dates are considered by the state of Oregon to be rare, threatened or endangered. The abundance of each taxon is indicated by a number reflecting how often the plants have been collected and a specimen deposited in OSC: 1 = Rare (1–4 specimens), 2 = Frequent (5–15 specimens), 3 = Common (16 or more specimens). An "X" indicates a native taxon that has not been collected in the county in the last 50 years and is arbitrarily presumed to be extirpated.
